It's great to know that we will be reopening at the start of August 2020. We would like to reassure you that following the recent government guidelines, we are taking all the necessary precautions to ensure your safety as well as that of our employees. Whilst things cannot yet return to how they were before, our team have been trained in a range of new operational procedures and we are confident that we can still give you the usual standard of Miners service.

We strongly recommend booking before arrival to avoid any disappointments. We have had to adapt our food & drink offering initially so that we can settle in to a new way of working – we will keep to The Miners way and change main menu daily using as always the best local produce, we also put in place pub classic dishes as well. Government guidelines remain fluid and can change quickly so please do check our Important things you should know before you arrive are:

Please be courteous and work with us to comply with social distancing rules. On arrival – please read the Miners new rules on the blackboard just outside the front door, sanitise your hands. And then sign in, we have put in place a QR operation also Inside – you will be shown to your table by a member of staff and we will do the rest. (PLEASE NOTE - only 2 households on any 1 table Max of 6 people) If you wish to dine outside, again you will first need to enter the front door and wait for a member of staff to show you to a table). PLEASE NOTE - with adverse weather if we are full inside you cannot come in. Other than using the toilets or smoking area please remain at your allocated table – do not go to the bar.

Please observe social distancing rules of 1 metre plus. These are challenging and trying times for us all. Please be kind, respectful, compassionate and have patience. We are all in this together and welcome any feedback to improve the 'new normal'. By entering these premises you have agreed to abide by the above.
